



Common Questions Asked by Parents



1. Will my child be able to call home?

We hope your child will be so busy that they won't have time to think about calling home! However, if a real need does arise, the BHDM Directors will call the parents. We ask that the camper does not bring their own cell phone to camp.

2. What do I do if my child should become homesick?

Please encourage your child to stay at camp. In the event that your child becomes severely homesick, we will contact you to come pick them up from camp.

3. Can I visit my child at camp?

Due to volume and safety of children at camp, visitors are not permitted during camp.

4. What is the Counselor/Camper ratio?

Each Counselor/Junior Counselor pair will have 6-10 campers.

5. Will my child be with his/her friends while at camp?

On your registration card you should have identified one friend that your child would like to be with at camp. We guarantee that your child will be with that one friend. We understand the importance of friendships at camp, it is extremely important to us that each child feels comfortable while at camp.

6. How can I help my child have a positive camp experience?

Daily pray for your child and his/her counselor. Take a positive approach in preparing your child for camp. Help your child understand the importance of obeying camp and cabin rules.
